

Jointly supervised inter-university graduate student scholarship

- A. The student must submit his CV, copy of a transcript and a short research plan. The award will become effective starting the following term.

- B. The student should be in the first year for M.Sc. and for Ph.D. in 1-3 yr at the time of the application. The actual use of the award can be before or during the last year of research. Students who are already being co-supervised are eligible to apply for the award.

- C. The award is for \$5000 and can be renewed for a second year for a Ph.D. student.

ELIGIBILITY:

- i. The research plan should clearly outline what work will be done in which lab.

- ii. The student should regularly attend group meetings for both supervisors and presents his research results to both groups.

- iii. A progress report will be submitted. For renewal of the award there needs to be evidence that the work will produce a joint publication - the student has or will present the work at a conference, or an actual preprint. The student will present his work (oral presentation) at the CSACS student symposium.
